Netherlands Co. Signs Home Energy Americas To Exclusive Agreement

McKinney, Texas (October 15, 2008) – **Home Energy Americas, LLC (HEA)** has signed a cooperative agreement with Home Energy International B.V. (HEI) of The Netherlands making HEA exclusively responsible for sales of HEI's innovative products in the Americas. HEA has four product lines: small wind turbines (Energy Ball™), solar PV panels, solar heat tubes, and bio-furnaces. All products are currently manufactured in Europe and have been successfully installed there for over two years. Energy Ball™ manufacturing is expected to begin late this year in McKinney, Texas. HEI expects HEA to take the lead in market development and sales for North/Central/South America, and the Caribbean. "We anticipate UL certification very soon on HEI's proprietary inverter for the V-100 Energy Ball™ small wind turbine, to be immediately followed by the V-200 inverter," says **Robert Thompson**, CEO of HEA. "It is one of the first in a new generation of inverters designed specifically for small wind. With rapid response power curve tracking, the increased efficiency raises the bar for output performance by capturing nearly all of the available production of a small turbine operating at variable wind speeds." Mr. Thompson goes on to say that, "The V-100's patented blade design resembles a spinning ball and takes advantage of the 'Venturi effect', also affording more power over a wide range of wind speeds. Greater efficiency, combined with light weight and near silent operation, makes the Energy Ball™ series of small wind turbines an excellent fit for many residential and small business applications."
